This noble instrument, originally consisting of two manuals only, was built in 1860, removed from the West end of the Church, and enlarged by adding a third row of keys (Choir Organ), and several stops to Pedal Organ in 1861-2; it has also undergone entire re-construction, and a new Solo Organ, Pneumatic Lever action to great and swell, and the 4th row of keys were added in 1880, from specifications by Mr. W. Haynes (Organist for the past 44 years), under whose immediate direction, the instrument (now considered one of the most perfect Organs in the Country), was rebuilt in 1880.
