Grade II*

St Chad, Norton-in-Hales, Shropshire

J.W.Walker 1864 & 1878 2/15 NPOR ref: H00116

A village church organ by a major Victorian builder, almost unaltered. Richly decorated front pipes.

Baptist Church, Upton-upon-Severn, Worcestershire

Banfield 1853 1/6 NPOR ref: P01107

A significant example of the work of John Banfield of Birmingham Long compass manual with 18-note pedalboard permanently coupled to manual.

Baptist Church, Penzance, Cornwall

Hele 1896 3/29 NPOR ref: D05161

A significant and versatile organ by Hele & Co. of Plymouth incorporating some Bryceson pipes from 1865. In largely original condition.

St Ia the Virgin, St Ives, Cornwall

Hele 1907 3/36 NPOR ref: D04832

This listing is for the very fine organ case, an important item of ecclesiastical furnishing from 1907 by Violet Pinwill in relation to her other works in the building. One of her rare case designs.

Forster & Andrews 1895 2/16 NPOR ref: R000317

A well-preserved instrument by Forster & Andrews of 1895, constructed in the final years of the Joseph Andrews era.
