### **Grade II\***

#### **St Paternus, South Petherwin, Cornwall**

Heard & Sons, Truro 1907 2/11 NPOR ref: V00583

A fine and unaltered example of the work of Heard & Sons of Truro, a regional firm active in the early decades of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

#### **Christ Church, Skipton, Yorkshire**

Harrison & Harrison 1906 2/22 NPOR ref: N05080

plus 5-stop Solo division prepared for at console

A remarkably intact example of the work of Harrison & Harrison in 1906; an important period in the history of the tonal development of the firm.

### **Grade II**

#### **Holy Trinity, Bosbury, Herefordshire**

Speechly & Ingram 1871 3/29 NPOR ref: N09341

A notable and substantial survival of 1871 from the partnership of Speechly & Ingram, as augmented in 1897 but retaining all original pipework, mechanism and case.

#### **Leominster Priory, Herefordshire**

Bevington & Sons 1853 1/5 NPOR ref: N09758

A little-altered survival of an early organ by an important Victorian builder.
